The Chronic Wasting Disease Rule Proposal Republished for Comment

Austin, TX – The Texas Animal Health Commission’s (TAHC) Chronic Wasting Disease rule proposal originally published for comment on December 30, 2016, has been republished in today’s issue of the *Texas Register*, due to editing errors.

The original rule publication in the *Texas Register* omitted subsections (f) - (h). The purpose of the proposed amendment to Chapter 40, Chronic Wasting Disease, Surveillance Testing Requirements is to add surveillance, movement reporting, identification, and record keeping requirements for Exotic CWD Susceptible Species.

The comment period is now extended and the deadline for submissions on the proposed rule is February 20, 2017. Please note that the rule proposal posted on the TAHC website on December 30, 2016, is the correct version of the proposal.
